And God called the light, Day, and the darknesse he called, Night: and the euening and the morning were the first day. ¶ And God said, Let there be a firmament in the middest of the waters: and let it divide the waters from the waters. And God made the firmament; and divided the waters, which were vnder the firmament, from the waters, which were above the firmament: and it was so. And God called the firmament, Heaven: and the euening & the morning were the second day. ¶ And God said, Let the waters vnder the heauen be gathered together vnto one place, and let the drie land appeare: and it was so. And God called the drie land, Earth, and the gathering together of the waters called he, Seas: and God saw that it was good. And God said, Let the earth bring foorth grasse, the herbe yeelding seed, and the fruit tree, yeelding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in it selfe vpon the earth: and it was so. And the earth brought foorth grasse, and herbe yeelding seed after his kind, and the tree yeelding fruit, whose seed was in itselfe, after his kind: and God saw that it was good. And the euening and the morning were the third day. ¶ And God said, Let there bee lights in the firmament of the heauen, to divide the day from the night: and let them bee for signes and for seasons, and for days and yeeres. And let them bee for lights in the firmament of the heauen, to give light vpon the earth: and it was so. And God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the starres also. And God set them in the firmament of the heauen to giue light vpon the earth: And to rule ouer the day, and ouer the night, and to divide the light from the darknesse: and God saw that it was good. And the euening and the morning were the fourth day. And God said, Let the waters bring foorth abundantly the moouing creature that hath life, and fowle that may flie aboue the earth in the open firmament of the heauen. And God created great whales, and euery living creature that mooueth, which the waters brought forth abundantly after their kind, and euery winged foule after his kind: and God saw that it was good. And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitfull, and multiply, and fill the waters in the Seas, and let foule multiply in the earth. And the euening and the morning were the fift day. ¶ And God said, Let the earth bring forth the liuing creature after his kind, cattell and creeping thing, and beast of the earth, after his kind: and it was so. And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattell after their kinde, and euery thing that creepeth vpon the earth, after his kind: and God saw that it was good. ¶ And God said, Let us make man in Our Image, after our likenesse: and let them have dominion ouer the fish of the sea, and ouer the foule of the ayre, and ouer the cattell, and ouer all the earth, and ouer euery creeping thing that creepeth vpon the earth. So God created man in his own Image, in the Image of God created hee him: male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said vnto them, Be fruitfull and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it, and have dominion ouer the fish of the Sea, and ouer the foule of the ayre, and ouer euery living thing that mooueth vpon the earth. ¶ And God said, Behold, I haue given you every herbe bearing seed, which is vpon the face of all the earth, and euery tree in the which is the fruit of a tree yeelding seed, to you it shall be for meat: And to euery beast of the earth, and to euery foule of the ayre, and to euery thing that creepeth vpon the earth, wherein there is life, I haue giuen euery greene herbe for meat: and it was so. And God saw euery thing that hee had made: and behold, it was very good. And the euening and the morning were the sixt day.

IN the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in darknesse, and the darknesse comprehended it not.
